The school year has gotten off to a wonderful start! Our students are settled into routines and have been very engaged in their learning.

ADVANCED PLACEMENT UPDATE

- I am pleased to share that this year we are offering three Advanced Placement (AP) courses: **AP English 12, AP Biology 12, and AP Psychology 12**. We have 70 students enrolled in AP courses, reflecting a strong commitment to academic challenge and growth.
- I am also proud to let you know that last year's AP English 12 students achieved results **above the provincial average!** Go Devils!

LOCKERS

- We are pleased to let you know that every student will be issued a locker this week at no cost. To receive a locker, students must bring their own combination lock to the main office and provide the office with the lock combination. A locker will then be assigned to them.
- Locker distribution will take place at lunch according to the following schedule:
