Island View High School: Status Report from David Webber (June 6)

IVHS Administration and the Halifax Regional Centre for Education met with <u>David R. Webber</u>, P. Eng; Project Manager, Nova Scotia Department of Transportation & Infrastructural Renewal who confirmed we are committed to a September opening.

Island View High School is a new 3-storey 78,575 square foot state-of-the-art high school. It is designed to LEED (Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design) standards, and is expected to achieve LEED Silver designation.

The building will be ready for occupancy in time for the September 2018 school year. Construction work is proceeding to meet this occupancy date.

Outside, brickwork and siding is being installed. Later this summer, the landscaping will be completed and the driveways and parking areas will receive their final coat of asphalt.

Inside, drywall and painting is being completed, flooring is being installed, and cabinets and millwork are starting to roll in. Ceramic wall and floor tile is being installed.

The gymnasium wood floor has been installed, lines painted, and clear-coated. Furniture has been selected and ordered.

Installation of the building's mechanical and electrical systems is ongoing in preparation for commissioning, testing, and training for the school's operations staff. Work on the elevator is ongoing in preparation to having it commissioned and certified.

Water and air quality is a priority. To that end, all products (wall and floor materials, furniture, etc.) and installation materials (paints, adhesives, etc.) were scrutinized to ensure that each was low to no odor and met LEED standards. Tests will be done prior to occupancy to confirm that water and air quality are within acceptable guidelines.

Following occupancy, there will be a one year warranty on the building. During that period, the project team: contractor, building designers, Transportation and Infrastructure Renewal, and HRCE will all be monitoring the building. They will be prepared to address any issues and answer any questions.
